As the object of these notices is to afford the Inspector every facility and opportunity for inspecting the work as it proceeds, the following instructions are to be observed in filling in the above notice.

(a) At the start of the work, the word "START" to be inserted. Should the Licensee wish to temporarily cease work the word "CEASE" to be inserted. And on resuming work, the word "RESUME" to be inserted. Should a Licensee be prevented by the weather or any other cause from proceeding with the work in accordance with his notice, intimation of same must be forwarded to the Inspector and further notice given of his intention to start work.

(b) Insert locality

**NOTE.**—Should a stoppage involve any work being taken down and re-erected, or the breaking into and amending any internal or external pipe, notice must be given as hereinbefore provided for new work.

**NOTICES** to be forwarded not later than **THE DAY BEFORE** it is proposed to commence work.

**THE OMISSION** or neglect to forward the above notices as occasion may require will lead to cancellation of the License.

**NOTE.**—This Notice must be accompanied by the Fee payable under Section 397 of the By-Laws
