Dear Sir,

In the course of an inspection for refund of your Vehicle Crossing Deposit, I observed that the footpath fronting your new dwelling has been damaged, over a total distance of 15 metres, due to building operations on the site.

Furthermore, there was no enquiry made by yourself or your agent, for footpath damage existing prior to the commencement of the construction.

The total cost to Council for the reinstatement of the said footpath will be \$120-00, and upon receipt of this sum, or the balance of \$40-00 to be added to the Vehicle Crossing deposit already to hand, I will instruct the Streetworks Department to repair the damage that now exists.

Alternately, your own staff, or contractor, may undertake the upgrading of the footpath, but, this must be done to the standards and requirements of Council.
