UPDATING OF YOUR PROPERTY FILE: 100 PUKUATUA STREET

Council has recently updated all the property files held by the Rotorua District Council. This updating process has included a review of known, or likely to exist, hazards. The term hazard refers to circumstances relating to the land that the Council is aware of. These circumstances may affect the present condition of the land. For example a hazard may include unconsolidated or sawdust fill on a property, geothermal activity, possibility of flooding, unstable ground, or a similar situation that is known to the Council.

Your Property File

Your property has been identified as having:

Fill	This relates to the controlled or uncontrolled fill known to be present on the property identified. This notice usually requires further investigation should building work proceed.
Geothermal	This relates to known hot spots, production bores or areas of geothermal risk on the property identified.
Inundation	This relates to the potential flooding of the property identified.

Council has therefore updated your property file to include the above notice/s.

If you wish to review your property file please bring this letter with you to the Records Section, which is where your property file is kept.
