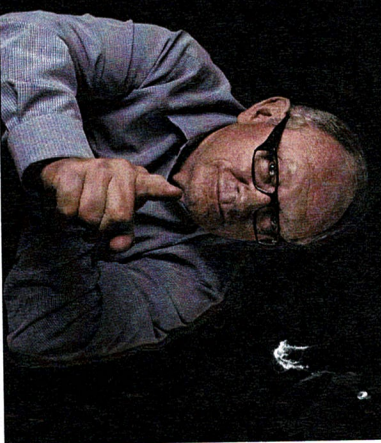
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Key's **Incredibly Useful Guide to** BUYING CARPET



1) **HEAVY DUTY** or **EXTRA HEAVY DUTY?**

You might be surprised to know there's a pretty big difference between these two grades.

They're industry wide definitions and they must meet certain specifications to be able to be named as such.

HEAVY DUTY is actually designed for reasonably low traffic flows and used a lot in the spec home market.

EXTRA HEAVY DUTY is recommended for any area with high traffic flow or in a home where you plan to stay and live.

MEDIUM and **LIGHT DUTY** won't really cut the mustard when it comes to long term use.

2) **What FIBRE and why?**

Call me old fashioned, but when someone says 'carpet' I've always thought 'wool'. Sort of comes with the territory when you're a kiwi.

But my attitude has changed since I did the whole recarpeting thing recently. So here's what I now think is important to know.

SOLUTION DYED NYLON is the most durable yarn currently on the market. Good ones look and feel surprisingly luxurious, and they certainly don't look 'synthetic'. They're brilliant to clean and can stand up to a real thrashing.

SOLUTION DYED POLYESTERS, POLY-PROPS and other **SYNTHETICS** are cheaper and less durable yarns. Unfortunately this is not always reflected in the retail price, as a lot of consumers assume solution dyed synthetics are all the same. This is often not clearly explained by retailers.

BLENDED PRODUCTS such as 50/50 blends are a way to make a product cheaper, but not necessarily better. Regardless of whether you choose 100% Wool or 100% Synthetic, they're a better choice than a 50/50 blend.



3) **Weight Matters**

The weight and density of a carpet will have a direct effect on its performance, so it's important to know exactly what you are paying for.

Carpet weight refers to the weight of the yarn in every meter of carpet excluding the backing, while the density refers to how close together the fibres are.

Two carpets which appear to be the same in length or pile height can have very different stitch rates - the further apart the fibres, the more quickly the carpet will flatten.

New Zealand uses the metric system for weight, so it makes sense for our carpets to be in kilos rather than ounces. Some other companies give you the weight in ounces per square yard. You can easily convert kilos per lineal meter to ounces per square yard by multiplying the number by 8. For example a 5kg carpet is 40oz.



8) Consumer Trusted

I could sing Carpet Mill's praises 'til the cows come home- but you don't need to just take my word for it, Carpet Mill is accredited as a **Consumer Trusted** Business. For those of you who are not familiar with Consumer NZ, they are a non-profit organization dedicated to ensuring New Zealand consumers get a fair deal. Isn't that what we all want?

9) Shop Local! Is your carpet New Zealand made?

Buying your carpet from Carpet Mill means supporting local businesses. The sales rep and installers are locals to your area, and even the carpet is made right here in New Zealand! What better way to support your local economy than purchasing a New Zealand made product from your regional sales representative?!



10) Warranties

Is the installation guaranteed for the life of the carpet? It is with **Carpet Mill**.

Carpet Mill offer a realistic warranty time frame on all of their carpets which can be viewed on the website. They want you, their customers, to be lifetime customers.

They love it when people tell their friends that they've had a top notch experience, because at the end of the day that's their best form of advertising. Not wanting to do myself out of a job, mind you.

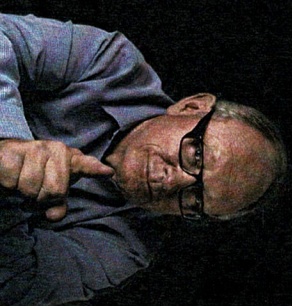
So of course all reasonable complaints will be attended to with the aim of resolving them to the customer's satisfaction.

Take a look at Carpet Mills warranty - it's really simple and straight forward. Look into warranties that seem too good to be true, because they probably are. You'll find some offer warranty booklets with pages and pages - of guess what? Exclusions. So it might all look fabulous in the first couple of pages - but make sure you check the pages at the back, that's where the tricky bits hide.

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We come to your place!



4) Shading and tracking

This is a big issue for lots of people, but the fact is, all **CUT PILE** carpet will show tracking and shading to some extent. It looks a bit like a bush walk through your carpet, but if you select your product wisely there are ways to greatly decrease the appearance of shading and tracking.

Avoid carpets with really long loose piles, because the longer the carpet the more likely it is to track. Short, dense piles minimise tracking. Run your hands through the pile of your carpet samples - the more the pile moves under your hands the more likely you are to see where you walk and where you do not.

Make sure if you are looking at longer, plushier piles for the more luxury feel, that your carpet is of dense construction and the fibres are packed tightly together.

Tracking and shading are not manufacturing faults - shading is actually considered to be a feature of the carpet. If you really hate it, then you should go for a loop pile.

5) Underlay

Just like building a house on solid foundations, your new carpet needs to be installed on the right underlay in order for it to perform as it should.

Underlay is measured in both thickness and (more importantly), density or weight.

Thickness of between 10mm - 12mm is recommended for luxury and comfort; not too thin and not too high.

When choosing a weight / density, 90kg is a decent standard grade while 110kg - 120kg is the better quality option.

If underlay is very dense, ie. 130kg or above, it can end up feeling quite firm, and lose the soft luxurious feel that underlay was designed for.

6) Do you know what you are paying for?

Cautionary note from Kev - always ask for an itemised quote.

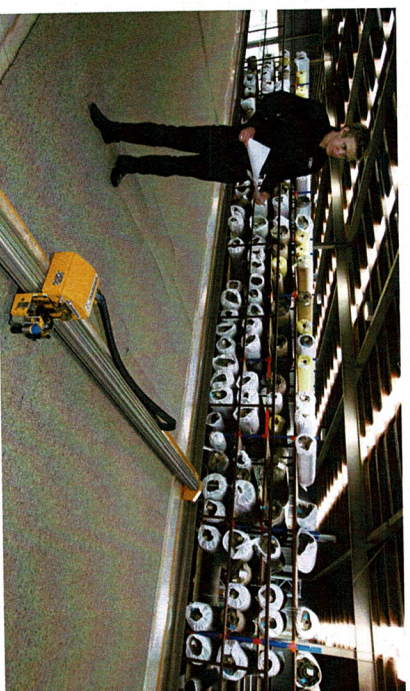
Itemised quotes show you what you have been quoted for. Sounds obvious, but lots of people don't ask for them and end up with costs they hadn't bargained for.

For example, if uplifting the old carpet is included you know exactly what you would save if you opted to do that yourselves.

Carpet Mill even itemise freight and robotic cutting content, so that again, if it's not required, you know how much you would save by arranging it or doing it yourself. That's fair don't you reckon?

7) Planning, joining, shape cutting and installation

Carpet Mill can provide you with a copy of your join plan prior to having your carpet installed so you can see exactly where your joins are going to be. They then shape cut your carpet with a robotic cutting machine.



This means your carpet arrives on site pre-cut and ready to lay. The big advantages of this are MUCH faster installation times, no big pieces of carpet scraping against your doors and walls, a whole lot less wastage and no large rolls being cut in your driveway - which is a complete nightmare when the weather isn't co-operating.

Carpet Mill guarantee the installation for the lifetime of your carpet. So there you go.

The carpet should provide satisfactory wear, and be free from manufacturing defects for the years as stated below. The carpet will retain at least 90% of its pile fibre for the years as stated below.

15 Year Warranty: Casa Bella 4kg, Casa Bella 5kg, Casa Bella 7kg, Casa Bella 9kg, Valenciana 4kg, Valenciana 5kg, Valenciana 7kg, Valenciana 9kg, Cadrona, Sinta, Luna 6kg, Luna 8kg
10 Year Warranty: Casa Bella 3kg, Valenciana 3kg, Naples.
8 Year Warranty: Galaxy 6.8kg.

Subject to:

Regular maintenance, protection from strong sunlight and normal wear and tear.

The Remedy:

All faulty products will either be replaced, or repaired at no cost, and with a minimum of inconvenience to the customer.

Expectation:

The more you can move the pile with your hand the more the carpet will show the difference where you walk and where you don't. All cut pile carpets will shade and track. However, a 2 ply short and dense pile will shade and track a lot less than a long loose pile.

A velour (plush) pile is designed to shade. This is a feature of the carpet if a luxury look is required. As the plush pile continuously moves it will disguise tracking as it creates a velour design.

Loop pile constructions do not show tracking and shading the same as cut pile constructions do.

You need to know:

The best carpets are made from a 2 ply yarn and are of a short and tight construction, either 100% wool, or 100% SDN (fibre used in our Cadrona, Valenciana and Casa Bella ranges) is best. We do not recommend wool blends, cut pile polypropylene, cut pile polyester or any product made from acrylic. Wool blends and alternate fibres are a way to make carpet cheaper, not better.

Regular maintenance to keep your carpet looking better for longer:

Vacuum all of your carpet regularly, including behind beds, doors etc. We recommend that you use a 'turbo head' on loop pile carpet once every 2 months and on a cut pile

every 4 months. This ensures that all the spare fibre is removed. It is important to use a good vacuum cleaner.

Wool Carpets and Carpet Beetles:

While all Woolmark carpets are resistant to moths and carpet beetles, they can still be damaged by them. Regular vacuum cleaning will help prevent damage. Spraying the edges with carpet and bedding spray is strongly recommended (available from the supermarket in the pet department). Synthetic fibres are not affected by carpet beetle.

Strong sunlight will fade carpets, fabrics and furniture. Solution dyed fibres are more resistant than others.

Carpets not protected from castor chairs will be void of warranties.

Peeking joins are a natural occurrence in your installation. Certain light falls can accentuate this giving a sand dune effect. This may be perceived as a colour variation on the join.

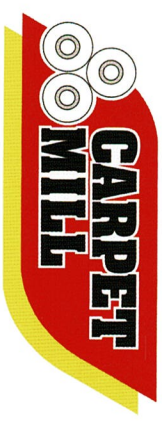
Like other fabrics, carpets will vary in colour and/or texture from dye-lot to dye-lot and from the supplied sample.

If we are providing an installation service for you, Carpet Mill warrants the installation for the time period equal to your carpet warranty.

Join plans are always available on request.

No fibre loss: Our NYLON6 COLOUR FAST SD is made of bulk continuous filaments so there is no pollution from small fibre segments.

Antistatic: Our NYLON6 COLOUR FAST SD carpets are anti-static, this is achieved with carbon strands within the yarn.

The future: Your NYLON6 COLOUR FAST SD carpet purchase is durable and hard wearing, once it settles down from being new it will serve you for many years to come. If you wish to change carpet for any reason (renovations, colour change, etc) we are ready to get your old carpet processed for regeneration. The carpet fibres will be totally regenerated for the next consumer to produce new durable products, including carpet.

When did we start regeneration: We are doing it right now! All waste and off cuts, when they can be reasonably recovered, are compacted and processed for regeneration already. Obviously as our carpets are durable we are not expecting any volume for quite some time.

Please note: NYLON6 COLOUR FAST SD is the only carpet fibre that can be regenerated. NYLON6 COLOUR FAST SD is currently a superior fibre to others on the market. Not all Nylon can be regenerated e.g. Nylon66 can't, neither can Solution Dyed Polypropylene or Solution Dyed Polyester be fully regenerated.

Other green initiatives:

Remanufacturing of cardboard: All of our cardboard (where possible) is compacted and returned for remanufacturing.

Regeneration of water: Hot water is regenerated and re-used. Wastewater is treated on site and approved to be disposed into the councils waste water system.

The best carpets are:

Carpet structure: Short and tight carpets will perform longer and better. Long and soft carpets will show tracking quite quickly (the difference where you walk and where you don't). The more you can move the pile with your hand the more it will track.

100% deposit guarantee: We have a term deposit as required to be accredited for the **CONSUMER TRUSTED** tick. This deposit is to ensure that any of our customers deposits are secured no matter what. Franchised CARPET MILL outlets are also covered. As this letter is supplied to you from an approved CARPET MILL dealer your deposit is secured.
