REPORT ACCESS TO LOTS 8 & 9 RATA STREET

It is proposed to form access from Rata Street, Waipapakauri Ramp, onto Lots 8 & 9 by utilising sand removed from the beach access by McBreen Jenkins as part of their maintenance work.

The entrance way will be formed as a shared access with a 6m wide crossing. The area effected will be approximately 125 m². The average depth of fill in the hollow would be 800mm requiring 48 m³ of fill to give a driveway grade of 1 in 6.

It is proposed to strip the denser vegetation before placing the fill. A watercart will be needed to damp the sand to ensure compaction if conditions are dry.

Following the placement of sand the surface will be covered with shale metal and compacted. The exposed sides will be covered with strippings of soil and kikuyu grass.

It is anticipated this work will be completed in one operation when McBreens are next in the area.

The attached plan shows the extent of the work.

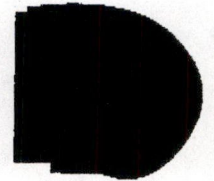
