give notice that the stormwater and sewer on the above property has been separated.
I attach my drainage plans detailing the location of all soak pits or other installations for your records (see example of typical site plan on page 30).

I accept any risks associated with the installation of any soak pits on the above property, and I accept that at times they may overflow during heavy rainfall and will periodically require maintenance.

If the soak pits do not prove to be sufficient to perform satisfactorily, or if my drainage system causes any nuisance outside my property, then I acknowledge that I will need to rectify the problem to the Council's satisfaction.

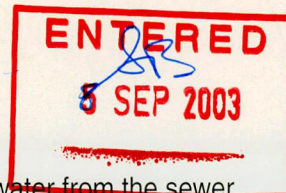

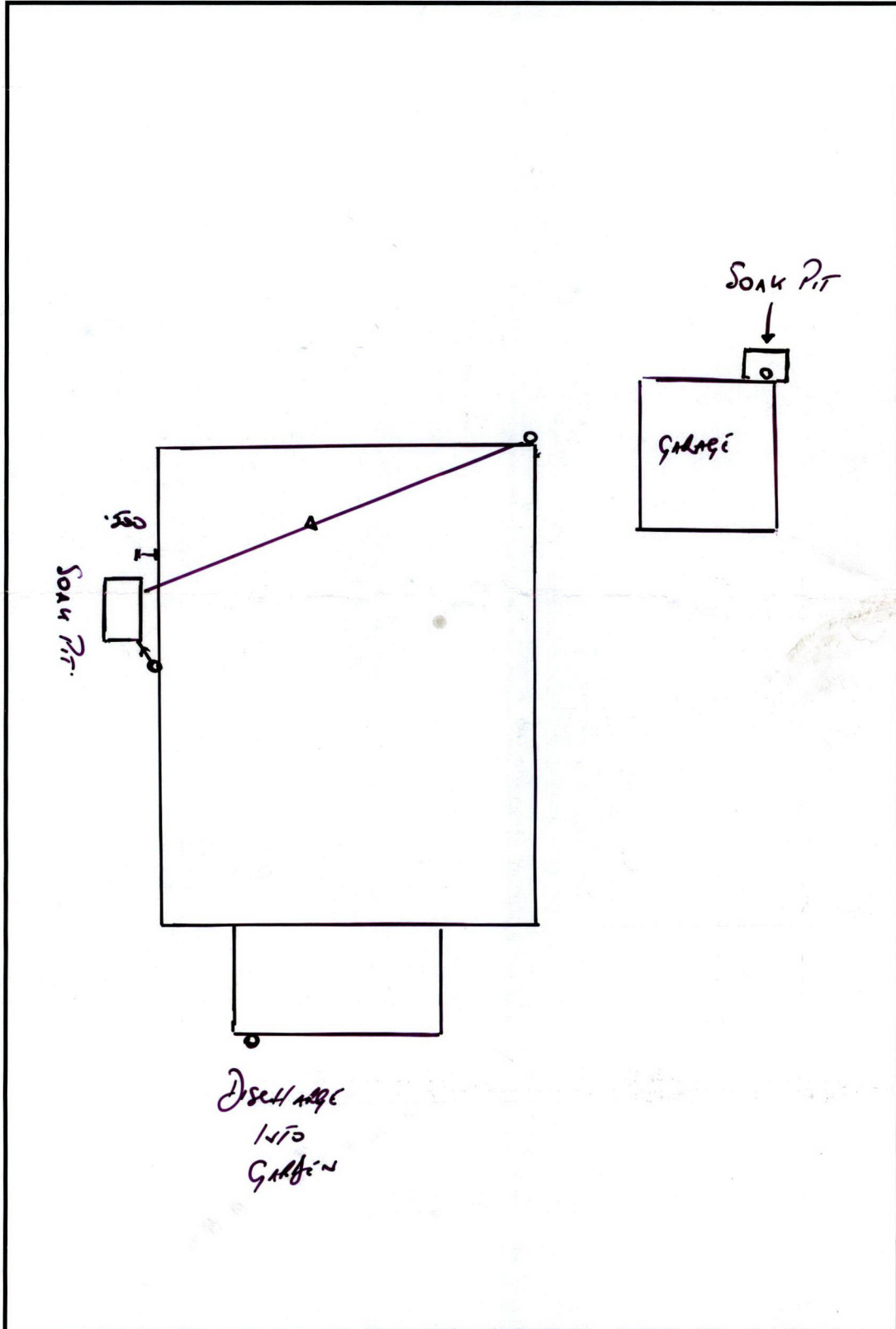

Stormwater Separation of Private Property at 23 Nile St

The Wanganui District Council served notice in December 2000 on all property owners to separate stormwater discharged from privately owned properties from the sewerage disposal system in accordance with section 459 of the Local Government Act 1974. Council published and distributed "Wanganui's Stormwater Separation Guide" to set out and explain the requirements and stages in the process. The deadline to remove stormwater from the sewer servicing private properties in Wanganui East was 1 July 2003. The majority of properties in Wanganui East have now completed separation.

According to our records, your property has not been confirmed as having had stormwater separated from the sewerage system. If that is the case, given that the deadline of 1 July 2003 has passed, Council will now have to take steps to ensure that separation occurs.

As the property owner, you are responsible to complete separation on your property. You are requested to complete and return this letter in the self-addressed envelope by 5th of September 2003 setting out whether you consider that separation has already occurred and, if not, your proposed course of action.

- Separation work has been completed and the signed declaration and site plan in the Separation Guide are attached.
- I have accepted a quote from _____ (Drainlayer) who will complete all work and return the declaration and site plan by ___/___/___
- I will complete the separation work myself and return the declaration and site plan by ___/___/___
- I agree to Council completing the separation works on my behalf. This involves design of the works, obtaining a quote from Council's approved contractors and discussing with me prior to undertaking the works.
- I would like to discuss separation on my property with someone at Council.
